Presbytery of Paris

Historical Sketch

The Presbytery of Paris was constituted in 1875. The records for Penmarvian (Home for the Aged) are contained within this presbytery. The accession number for the Penmarvian records is 1992-3465. Penmarvian, located in Paris, Ont., was originally built by Mr. Hiram Capron, the founder of Paris, between the years 1845-1848. The house was later owned by Mr. John Penman; the name "Penmarvian" is derived from his name (Penman) and his wife's name (Martha). After his death in 1931, the house and grounds were bequeathed to the Presbyterian Church in Canada. Penman's wish was that the house be used as a residence for retired ministers, missionaries, their wives and widows, and if the Presbyterian Church in Canada saw fit to operate such a residence there, there was also a sum of \$100,000.00 provided to help in the upkeep of the institution.

Between the years 1938-1969, the Presbyterian Church operated Penmarvian as a Home for the Aged, with an important stipulation that guests had to be physically able to look after themselves (Penmarvian did not possess hospital or nursing facilities). Extensive repairs to the house became necessary by 1949, and by 1959, occupancy was less than half of the peak in 1948, and the incoming revenue was not enough to cover the many costs of repairs. Residence rates were increased, and the home was made available to all Presbyterians, but in 1969 the home was closed because it was too costly to operate.

In 1970, the Presbytery of Paris sought to have Penmarvian turned over to them and have it continue as a residence for seniors. In 1972, Penmarvian was organized as a charitable corporation ("Penmarvian of Paris, Inc.") and together with a National Development Fund grant and a grant from the provincial government, it was re-opened as a home for the aged of any religious affiliation. The Presbytery of Paris had bought Penmarvian from the Presbyterian Church for the sum of \$1.00 in the same year.

However, in 1976, the home again became too costly to maintain and a decision was made to sell Penmarvian. The charter of Penmarvian of Paris was surrendered and its charitable status revoked. After the home closed in 1977, the Penmarvian Estate was sold to Mr. John Van Gastel. The money from the sale went to the Presbyterian Church in Canada.

In 1930, Ms. Mary Morgan bequeathed her home in the Village of Markham to the Presbyterian Church in Canada to be used as a home or hospital for sick, infirm, or aged ministers or missionaries. Known as the Morgan Memorial House, the home began to receive residents in 1935. A Joint Committee was established in charge of both the Morgan Memorial House and Penmarvian.
