## Notes on using the Finding Aid

First consult the fonds description (fonds being an archival term used to denote the whole of the records created by a specific individual or family and held within an archives). The fonds description includes a biographical sketch of the individual or family that created the records, a scope and content note which briefly describes the records within the fonds (this generally starts with "Fonds consists of..."), and several notes at the bottom, which provide information on access restrictions and copyright restrictions.

Some finding aids also provide series descriptions on subsequent pages which further describe the records within the fonds.

After reading these descriptions consult the file list and notify an archivist of the individual files you wish to view.

### **Fonds Description**

Frank Selkirk Morley fonds. – 1936-1985. - 91 cm of textual records. – 4 photographs. – 2 audio cassettes.

Frank Selkirk Morley was born on December 14<sup>th</sup>, 1904 in Huntsville, Ontario. He graduated from the University of British Columbia with an Arts degree, a Gold Medal in History and an I.O.D.E. Scholarship to the University of Edinburgh, where he received his Ph.D. in Constitutional Law and History, in 1932. On returning to Canada, he enrolled in Presbyterian College, Montreal, graduating with his Bachelor of Divinity. His first charge was in 1935 at Knox Church, St. Catharines, Ontario, From there, he went on to serve at Stanley Church in Westmount, Quebec, before being called to Grace Church in Calgary, Alberta, in 1944. In addition to his pastoral work in Calgary, he also taught at Mount Royal College, was Associate Editor of the Lethbridge Herald newspaper, a member of the Calgary Rotary Club, and was president of the Calgary Canadian Club. In 1962, Dr. Morley ran as a Liberal candidate for Calgary in the federal election. Dr. Morley was also a prolific writer of newspaper articles, with weekly columns entitled "The Voice of One" and "Weekend Meditations" in the Lethbridge Herald and Calgary Albertan. In 1963-64, he served as a member of the Canadian Delegation to the United Nations in New York. He served at St. Andrew's Church, Hamilton, Bermuda, from 1966 to 1971, and then at St. John's, White Rock, in British Columbia, from 1971 until he retired to Victoria. B.C. in 1979. He passed away on June 20<sup>th</sup>, 1986.

Fonds consists of sermons, articles, correspondence, personal papers and mementoes which document the life and activities of Dr. Morley. The sermons in the fonds were written by Dr. Frank Morley while minister at Grace Presbyterian Church, Calgary, and St. John's Presbyterian Church, White Rock, B.C. Two audio cassettes also exist with taped-recordings of two of his sermons. The articles include typescript copies of newspaper articles written by Morley between the early 1950s and late 1970s, as well as various religious booklets. A majority of the articles were written for his weekly columns in the Calgary Albertan and the Lethbridge Herald, titled "The Voice of One", and "Weekly Meditations". He also wrote editorials for both of these newspapers. The fonds also consists of personal papers, photographs and mementoes, including a small file of documents relating to his involvement in politics, a photograph of Dr. Morley with the other Canadian Delegates at the General Assembly of the United Nations in 1963, and various mementoes of his attendance at the Coronation of Queen Elizabeth II.

### **Series Descriptions**

#### Articles and addresses. – [194-]-[197-]. – 13 cm of textual records.

Series consists of articles written by Dr. Morton, primarily for the Calgary Albertan and the Lethbridge Herald. Dr. Morton wrote editorials for the Calgary Albertan from the late 1950s to the mid-1960s, and with the Lethbridge Herald in the mid-to-late 1960s. Additionally, he wrote two weekly columns - "The Voice of One", and "Weekly Meditations". "The Voice of One" was a general column which dealt with a variety of topics and subjects including culture and society, religion, history, and current affairs among others. The "Weekly Meditations" were more religiously based. The series also includes several files of miscellaneous articles and addresses written by Dr. Morley for various other newspapers and magazines, or presented at various functions.

#### Sermons. - 1944-1977. - 36 cm of textual records. - 2 audio cassettes.

Series consists of sermons written by Dr. Morley while minister at Grace Presbyterian Church, Calgary, Alberta and St. John's Presbyterian Church, White Rock, British Columbia. Also included are two audio cassettes of sermons given by Dr. Morley. Titles of these sermons are: "Faith Begins in the Family (Sept. 8<sup>th</sup>, 1974)", "God will Fulfil his Purpose for Me Nov. 9, 1972", and "Will your Church be Christian? (May 1975)".

#### Materials from seminars attended. - 1951-1970. - 3 cm of textual records.

Series consists of itineraries and some notes accumulated by Dr. Morley while attending various seminars around the world. Seminars attended include the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> International Theological Seminars in Germany, 1969 and 1970 (includes itinerary and papers presented); the Sherwood Eddy Seminars in 1951, 1953 and 1955 (includes an interview with President Tito); the American Seminar, 1951 (list of speakers); and a National Conference on the Problems of Canadian Unity, 1964 (list of participants).

#### Correspondence. - 1936-1985. - 11 cm of textual records.

Series consists of letters received by Dr. Morley between 1936 and 1985. The letters deal with a variety of topics including church-related business, correspondence regarding his activities with various associations and organisations, letters received as Associate Editor of the Lethbridge Herald, and personal correspondence with friends. One file consists of correspondence with Lester B. Pearson and John Diefenbaker concerning the possibility of Dr. Morley and Mrs. Morley meeting with Canadian Ambassadors while in Europe in 1959.

Personal papers, photographs and mementoes. - 1930-1985. - 28 cm of textual records. - 3 photographs.

Series consists of various papers and mementoes of Dr. Frank Morley including a file regarding his political involvement and his candidacy as a Liberal Member of Parliament for Calgary in 1962; a file of mementoes regarding his attendance at the Coronation of Queen Elizabeth II in 1953; a file of poems both written and collected by Dr. Morley; papers regarding his involvement in church activities; booklets and other writings, including his book "Why a Presbyterian Church?"; his Ph.D. thesis entitled "British Opinion on the Development of the Commonwealth", as well as three other school essays; and copies of the calls to Dr. Morley from Knox Presbyterian Church, St. Catharines, Ontario, Stanley Presbyterian Church, Westmount, Quebec, St. Andrew's Presbyterian Church, Hamilton, Bermuda, and St. John's Presbyterian Church, White Rock, British Columbia. The series also includes a portrait photograph of Dr. Morley, a photograph of Dr. and Mrs. Morley in London, U.K., and a photograph of members of the Delegation of Canada to the General Assembly of the United Nations (including Dr. Morley).
