Introduction

This record group is entitled the Administrative Records of the General Board of Missions/ Board of World Missions. The custodial history of the records lies solely with the two boards responsible for the creation of the records. Associated material can be found in Foreign Missions Collection 1880-1980 FA-MSFOR, Home Missions Collection 1944-1980 FA-MSHOM, and the Rev. Dr. E.H. Johnson Collection. Other material related to this fonds are the records of the Women's Missionary Society both Eastern and Western Divisions FA-WMS(ED), FA-WMS(WD), as well as records of the Church and University Committee pre 1973 which are unprocessed. Access is restricted to one record series, Field and Personal Reports, for 75 years after the date of creation, and another series, Special Ministries, is restricted for 20 years, that is until 1996. Other records of a sensitive nature were destroyed after consultation with the General Secretary of the Board of World Missions, Peter Ruddell. The Presbyterian Church in Canada Archives is grateful to the Canadian Council of Archives for the funding for this project through their Arrangement and Description Backlog Reduction Program. The records were processed by Donna Murphy between 1990 and 1991.

Historical Note

The Presbyterian Church in Canada has a very long history of activities in Mission fields both at home and abroad. In 1875 with the beginning of the Church, the Home Mission Board was established. Its purpose was to encourage the growth of the Church through mission activities. It was not until 1882 that the Foreign Mission Board came into existence. In 1925 following the question of Church Union came the General Board of Missions. This gave a cohesive base for almost all Mission functions. The Women's Missionary Societies were still acting somewhat independently. Then in 1967 at General Assembly there was an Overture from the Synod of the Atlantic Provinces to combine all mission activities under one roof. The result of studying the feasibility of this overture was that in 1971 at General Assembly the Board of World Mission came into being. The first meeting of the Board of World Mission occurred in November of 1971, although final internal organization was not achieved until after the 1972 General Assembly.

The internal structure of the Board has undergone many changes during its lifetime. The main Administrative divisions have been Home Missions, Foreign or Overseas Missions, Mission Education/Education for Mission, and Research and Planning. As necessary many small or temporary committees were set up to serve specific purposes in addition to the standing committees such as Finance, Business, Policy and Mission personnel. Details regarding the life of other committees will be found in series descriptions where applicable. The Board itself meets once a year, but for a short period met twice a year as is reflected in the records of the Annual Meeting.

Scope and Content Note

The Administrative Records of the General Board of Missions/Board of World Mission consist mainly of Committee Minutes, reports, agendas, and subject correspondence. Also found within the fonds are circular letters, memos, publications and flyers. Photographs and audio-visual material have been removed to the Graphic and Audio-Visual Collections respectively. With the exception of the aforementioned visual material, all records are textual. While most of the fonds is in good physical shape, there are a few items which are fragile or brittle. One thing worth noting is that because the correspondence is often with individuals who are overseas there is a large quantity of airmail letters and onion skin or very thin paper. These items can tear easily and caution should be used while handling them. Further accruals of administrative records are expected with the exception of those committees or divisions of the Board which have been discontinued.

The arrangement of the records follows both their use and the internal division of the Board. The minutes and a few other records of the Boards of Home and Foreign Missions which predate the formation of the General Board of Missions in 1925, were included in the finding aid. In general, the records were left in their original order with only minor alterations. The fonds was divided into eleven subgroups based on the divisions of the Board itself such as Overseas and Home Missions, or on the purpose of the records. One example of a subgroup is the records of the Annual Meeting which include minutes, reports and agendas. One artificial subgroup was created to house all of the publications which were found grouped in boxes as well as scattered throughout the fonds.

The first subgroup contains the records of the Annual Meeting of the General Board of Missions/Board of World Mission. This includes the minutes of the meeting, which may include the minutes of the executive committees. For more detail on these records please see the series description accompanying the Annual Meeting. Other records of the annual meeting are the reports to the Board from the various divisions, as well as the agendas. A number of reports to the General Assembly from the Board were found and these form the second subgroup.

Committee Minutes comprise the third subgroup. These were delineated to indicate which committees reported to a larger committee instead of reporting directly to the Board. The first series of this subgroup contains the minutes of those committees which report directly to the board and report only for themselves. Other committees which report directly to the board but that also report for other committees are listed following the first series. For example the Mission Education Committee reports directly to the Board yet also reports for the Audio-Visual and Calendar committees, therefore it is the fourth series.

Following the Committee Minutes, the next four subgroups are internal divisions of the Board and contain the administrative records of those divisions. For further information please refer to the subgroup and series descriptions of the specific division whether Home, Overseas, Mission Education, or Research and Planning. Second Century Advance for Christ was a special project which was carried out by the Board of World Mission in conjunction with the Board of Congregational Life. The minutes of the various committees and promotional material of the campaign comprise the eighth subgroup. The Policy Documents of the Board, guidelines and regulations for missionaries at home and overseas are the next subgroup. Something Extra follows the Policy documents, and includes only six issues at this time. Lastly appears the artificial subgroup of Publications. As they were found in no particular order and mixed in

with publications of other denominations it was decided to pull all of the publications together to facilitate access. For details of arrangement please see the subgroup note. Periodicals found with the fonds are listed following the publications.

The collection as a whole contains correspondence in french and oriental languages, and while the amount is small it illustrates the multilingual, multicultural nature of the Church. The Board especially Mission Education produced a large number of flyers, these will be found scattered throughout the correspondence. Only those illustrations of a Presbyterian nature have been noted in the finding aid and others may exist.

While the date range for the fonds is 1875-1988 the bulk of records range from 1950 through to the early 1980's with the other years being sparsely represented. There are a total of 11.5 meters of records in this fonds. More specifically, 587.5 cm is correspondence, 325 cm is minutes, 64.75 cm is reports, 30 cm is agendas and reports, 16 cm is policy documents and 30 cm is publications.

Subgroup Note

The Annual Meeting of the General Board of Missions/Board of World Missions is in March prior to General Assembly in June. It is from the reports submitted to the Annual Meeting that the Board extracts the necessary information for their report to the General Assembly. This subgroup consists of five series including Minutes, Reports, Agendas and Related Documents, Agendas and Reports, and Extracts of Minutes. Minutes of the Foreign Mission Committee/Board, one of the precursors to the General Board of Missions will be found in the first series of minutes.

The reports are divided into subseries to illustrate their originating body, that is, Home, or Overseas Missions. These are the reports to the Annual Meeting, they are not annual reports. In 1953 it was decided to publish an annual account of mission work for broad distribution within the Church. These published reports which include all areas of mission work (Home, Overseas, and Women's Missionary Societies) will be found in the Publications Subgroup under their titles. The Extracts of Minutes are exactly what their name implies, and for more detail of their arrangement please see the series description.

Series Description

OVERSEAS MISSIONS 1925-1982

Subgroup Note

The Secretary for Overseas Missions is responsible for the administrative functions of the overseas division as well as serving as member or secretary for many other committees. The Secretary also oversees incoming and outgoing Missionaries. The functions of the position have changed along with the internal restructuring, as well as through the passage of time. Individual secretaries can also shape the department through their own interests and involvement in causes or inter-church organizations.

The Rev. Dr. E.H. Johnson who held the position of Overseas Secretary from 1954 to 1973, was involved with many concerns both within and outside of the church. The bulk of records in this subgroup were created during his tenure as Secretary or in the years immediately following under the next secretary, the Rev. Dr. Earle F. Roberts. Dr. Johnson was involved in many inter-church projects as well as Canair Relief (for Nigeria-Biafra) and held membership on many of the Church's committees. His work is reflected in the records which consist of a wide array of correspondents as well as subjects. Dr. Johnson became involved with a number of foreign students who came to Canada to study. He corresponded with them regularly even after they returned to their native countries. He also corresponded with missionaries of the Presbyterian Church along with those of international denominations.

There are seven correspondence series in this subgroup. The divisions are based on the type of correspondence or on internal departments. Each of these divisions has a series description which gives further details on the content and arrangement of that particular series of records. Researchers should also see Overseas Missions under Committee Minutes, Annual Meeting Reports, and Annual Meeting Minutes-Annual and Executive.

Series Description

The records in this series are administrative subject correspondence files. While the date range is 1925-1976, the bulk of the records predate the formation of the Board of World Missions and were created following the appointment of Dr. Johnson as Secretary in 1954. HOME MISSIONS 1911-1982

Subgroup Note

Prior to the establishment of the General Board of Missions in 1925, Home Missions functioned separately as its own Board, and at one point (1916-1925) was linked with Social Action. Home Missions refers to mission work in Canada. There are nine series within this subgroup and some are quite small. These series indicate the different responsibilities and special projects of the Home Missions section of the Board. The first and largest series is the Administrative Correspondence. This correspondence is arranged in alphabetical order by file title, and the title indicates the subject matter of the file. As was the case with Overseas Missions the Administrative Correspondence from Home Missions is mainly composed of correspondence between the Secretary (J.A. Munro or H.A. Doig) and/or the Assistant Secretary. There are also some general files which are labelled "C" Correspondence. This title indicates a file which contains correspondence to and from persons, places or organizations which begins with the letter C.

The following eight series are in alphabetical order by title of the internal division of Home Missions. There are only one or two files of miscellaneous information for Evangel Hall, Kcnora Fellowship Centre, and Tyndale Neighbourhood House. There are Board Minutes and reports for Armagh, and Reports for Church Extension.

Administrative Correspondence 1927-1976

Series Description

This series is composed of the administrative records of the Home Missions section of the General Board of Missions/Board of World Missions. The bulk dates of the records are from the early 1950's to the mid 1970's. The correspondence is arranged in alphabetical order by file title. The subject of the file is reflected in the title. For the files which are labelled "A" Correspondence the subject matter can be anything from a person, place or organization which begins with the letter in quotation marks. An example would be to find correspondence from a minister under the letter of the alphabet with which his last name begins. A number of publications have been removed from files and transferred to the Publications section. The Minutes of the Committee and those committees which reported to it can be found at 1988-1003-31-4 to 1988-1003-35-8. Other minutes can be found with the minutes of the Board as the executive minutes were bound with minutes of the Board for various years. RESEARCH AND PLANNING 1973-1980

Series Description

Research and Planning was planned as a new division of the Board of World Mission in 1971 but did not actually come into being until 1973. Dr. E.H. Johnson who was Secretary for Overseas Missions from 1954-1973 became the first Secretary for Research and Planning. The purpose of the Committee was to examine the life of the Church, and in particular the projects and programs administered by the Board of World Mission in terms of 1) effectively communicating the gospel and 2) effective use of people and resources. Over the life span of the Committee (1973-1980), a number of task forces were created to delve into subject areas of concern to the Board. For instance, there were task forces on native peoples, the inner city and church extension which related to home missions work, as well as task forces on China, the Caribbean and Overseas Mission areas. Others were on Religious Pluralism, French-English relations, and Self Reliance in Mission. This committee passed out of existence in 1981 due to a restructuring of the Board. Dr. Johnson retired at the end of 1977 and was replaced by the Rev. C. Rodger Talbot, also formerly of Overseas Missions.

SECOND CENTURY ADVANCE FOR CHRIST 1975-1980

Subgroup Description

During the celebration of the Church's centennial in 1975, many began to look forward to the next one hundred years of the Church. At this point General Assembly sanctioned a Second Century Advance For Christ. Committees were established at the Executive and National level, with a third for Promotion and Publicity. The fund raising of the Advance was to carry on from 1977 to 1979. Among its purposes was "that the Gospel of Jesus Christ be advanced in new areas across Canada and Overseas", and "that by the power of the Spirit of God we make a Second Century Advance For Christ in prayer, Bible study, witness, fellowship and stewardship of time, talent and treasury".
