#### Introduction

This finding aid lists the records of both the Committee on the Order of Deaconesses, 1964-1967 and the Council of the Order of Deaconesses, 1969-1984. The Archives holds only a few publications and printed papers of the Committee and the Council which were transferred at various times between 1980 and 1987

The records were re-catalogued in February 1989 by Elspeth Reid.

This finding aid is listed as FA-DEACN.

#### Historical Sketch

The Committee on the Order of Deaconesses was authorized by the 1960 General Assembly on the recommendation of the Special Committee re. Examination for the Office of Deaconess. The Committee was to take over the responsibilities of a committee of the General Board of Missions on the Security of Deaconesses which dealt with their salaries, pensions and conditions of service. In addition, the committee was to keep a list of members of the Order of Deaconesses and a list of positions available, and it was to work on the possibility of transferable pension arrangements. The committee was to be composed of five persons not connected with any of the emplotting agencies - primarily the General Board of Missions and the Women's Missionary Societies. Over the yeasrs the committee worked to improve the salaries and status of the deaconesses and in the course of this published a booklet on the work of deaconesses in 1964. In the early 1970s with the re-structuring of the Boards and Committees of the Church, it was proposed that a single agency take charge of all church workers. The Committee on the Order of Deaconesses in 1973 indicated its willingness to participate but asked for

the right of maintaining our separate identity with the agency until such time as the place of Deaconesses within the Church has been clarified (Acts & Proceedings 1973 p.258)

The Commmittee on the Order of Deaconesses therefore proposed a Task Force on Deaconesses as part of the new Board and with this condition the work was transferred to the Board of Ministry in 1975.

The Council on the Order of Deaconesses was set up with the co-operation of the Committee on the Order of Deaconesses in 1968 as a bi-ennial conference for deaconesses to consider Council policy, hear papers and discuss mutual problems concerning their work" (Acts & Proceedings 1968 p.251.

#### Archival Arrangement

This collection of the records of the General Assembly's Committee on Deaconesses and the Council of Deaconesses consists mainly of approximately 10 cm of publications and printed papers, which are arranged in chronological order.
