### Fort Coulonge, Quebec St. Andrew's Presbyterian Church

#### Historical Sketch

St. Andrew's Presbyterian Church (Fort Coulonge, Quebec) was formed in 1856 and the congregation met at the home of the Bryson family. In 1863, the first church building was completed., a wooden structure. The first inducted minister was the Rev. Joseph Gandier who served from 1873 to 1890. Rev. Gandier's son Rev. Alfred Gandier was Principal of Knox College. A stone church was completed in February of 1891 and the wooden church and another parcel of land were sold. St. Andrew's was a self sustaining congregation from 1875 to 1975. Since that date it has been united with Bristol Memorial Presbyterian Church as a two-point charge. Rev (Lt. Col.) John Foote was minister of St. Andrew's from 1935 to 1936. He was later to be a recipient of the Victoria Cross in WWII and a monument was erected in his memory on property adjacent to the church in 1985.
