Jarvis, Ontario Knox Presbyterian Church

Historical Sketch

Knox Presbyterian Church (Jarvis, Ont.) was organized in 1856 by the Rev. William Craigie. The congregation was a part of the Free Church of Scotland until it joined The Presbyterian Church in Canada in 1875. The first minister to be inducted was the Rev. John McRobie who began his ministry to the joint charges of Jarvis and Chalmer's in 1857. A frame church was constructed in 1858. By July 1887, a new brick church had been built and was dedicated. During the time of Church Union in 1925, the majority of Knox members voted to remain a part of The Presbyterian Church in Canada. Another new church building was begun in 1946.
