Due to an influx of immigrants and refugees starting 1956, the congregation grew and bought a new building at 19th Avenue and Cambie Street in 1958. The church later moved again, buying the old Buchanan Presbyterian Church building on East 27th Avenue. The congregation became self-supporting in 1977.

The Rev. David Lister was called as the congregation's first minister. A church building was constructed and dedicated on March 27th, 1927. In 1955 and 1956 a new church, located at 2733 West 41st Avenue, was built. It was opened and dedicated on April 29th, 1956.

Vankleek Hill, Ontario Knox Presbyterian Church

Historical Sketch

Knox Presbyterian Church in Vankleek Hill, Ontario was established in 1825 by Rev. John McLaurin from Breadlabane, Scotland. A stone church was built in that year on the site of the present church manse, but was replaced with a brick building c.1859. In 1900, the congregation outgrew the brick church and it was decided to construct a larger church. The name "Knox Presbyterian Church" dates from this time. Tragically, the minister, Rev. John MacLeod, was killed when the rear wall of the church collapsed during construction. The new church was eventually opened and dedicated on June 16, 1901. A fire badly damaged the church in 1917, but it was repaired and re-opened in June 1918. The congregation voted to remain within The Presbyterian Church in Canada at the time of Church Union in 1925.

Knox Presbyterian Church, Vaughan was organized in 1845 as a United Presbyterian congregation linked with Albion. In 1875 the Vaughan congregation took the name of Knox. In 1876 the link with Albion was dissolved and Knox was linked with Bolton. In 1902 the charges were re-organized, and Knox, Vaughan was linked with Woodbridge while Bolton was linked with Nashville. In 1925 the minister, the Rev. J.A. Moir entered the United Church of Canada but the congregation remained Presbyterian. In 1961 Knox was amalgamated with Woodbridge and the church was closed.

Vaughan, Ontario St. Paul's Presbyterian Church

Historical Sketch

St. Paul's Presbyterian Church (Vaughan, Ont.) began with services every third Sunday lead by the Rev. McNaughton in 1838. The congregation was closely associated with St. Andrew's, Maple and was originally known as "St. Andrew's congregation on the seventh concession". A frame church was built in 1844. In 1863 the name St. Paul's was used. The congregation remained with The Presbyterian Church in Canada during the time of Church Union in 1925.

Historical Sketch

Woodbridge Presbyterian Church (Vaughan, Ont.) was established in 1874 by the Rev. Peter Nicol. The congregation was officially organized in 1875. For the first three years, services were held in the Temperance Hall. A church building was dedicated in December of 1877. The first minister was the Rev. R. Pettigrew who served from 1875 until 1884. Woodbridge Presbyterian Church remained with The Presbyterian Church in Canada during the time of Church Union in 1925. Knox Presbyterian Church, Vaughan amalgamated with Woodbridge in 1961.

Victoria, British Columbia St. Andrew's Presbyterian Church

Historical Sketch

St. Andrew's Presbyterian Church, Victoria was established in 1866 as a schism from First Presbyterian Church (now First Metropolitan United Church). Their first minister was the Rev. Thomas Somerville who served St. Andrew's from 1866 until 1871. In 1875, St. Andrew's was instrumental in forming the first (Church of Scotland) Presbytery in the West. In 1887 St. Andrew's severed its connection with the Church of Scotland and joined The Presbyterian Church in Canada. They voted to remain so in 1925. The congregation worshiped in a hall from its beginning in 1866 until the first church was built in 1869. A second (present) church was built in 1890 and a Kirk Hall was added in 1958.
