## PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH ASSOCIATION

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#### Introduction

This collection consists of approximately 3 metres of correspondence, minutes printed pamphlets and other records of the Presbyterian Church Association and its predecessor, the Organization for the Continuance of The Presbyterian Church in Canada, contained in two separate accessions. Accession #1973-1003 was retrieved from the vault of Knox College in 1973 and was given a preliminary listing at that time by N.K.Clifford. Accession #1982-1003 was transferred to the Presbyterian Archives in 1982-83 from the Head Offices of the Presbyterian Church in Canada. These two accessions are both listed within this finding all.

The records were re-catalogued and listed by Elspeth Reid in October and November 1988

#### Historical Sketch

The Presbyterian Church Association was formed in 1916 with the purpose of preventing the Presbyterian Church in Canada from participating in the transconfessional union proposed among the Presbyterians, the Methodist Church and the Congregational Church. The Association was a separate organization from the Presbyterian Church in Canada and was not officially acknowledged by the General Assembly. However, its membership included both laity and ministers, and it had branches within most of the Presbyteries and many of the congregations and the women's groups of the Church.

Between 1916 and 1925 the Presbyterian Church Association led the resistance to the church union movement within the Presbyterian Church in Canada. The Association published pamphlets and periodicals in a propaganda war against the Bureau of Literature and Information of the Joint Church Union Committee. The Association also fought a number of legal cases over local church unions and provided the main opposition to the passage of the United Church of Canada Acts in the Provincial and Dominion legislatures. It was this opposition which ensured the inclusion of a clause in the legislation to permit every congregation to vote on whether to enter the union or not. To finance this, the Association had to attract considerable funding from its membership and supporters and much of the work of the volunteer local organizers was spent in raising financial contributions.

Once it was clear that church union was inevitable, the Presbyterian Church Association attempted to salvage as much as possible of the existing Presbyterian Church in Canada in order to maintain the continuity of the denomination. Between 1924 and 1925 the leaders of the Association directed their efforts towards the voting in the congregations and in legal claims to the property and resources of the Presbyterian Church in Canada.

When the United Church of Canada was formed in 1925 the Presbyterian Church Association was dissolved. The leaders of the Presbyterian Church Association thereafter took prominent positions in the continuing Presbyterian Church in Canada.

A recent and reliable account of the role of the Presbyterian Church Association in the church union debate can be found in N. Keith Clifford <u>The Resistance to Church Union in Canada 1904-1939</u> University of British Columbia Press, Vancouver, 1985.

#### Archival Arrangement

This collection consists of two accessions of records of the Presbyterian Church Association and its predecessor, the Organization for the Continuance of The Presbyterian Church in Canada.

Accession #1973-1003 contains mainly correspondence files and a few reference files generated by the Secretary and other officers of the Presbyterian Church Association during two distinct periods: between 1914 and 1918, and between 1922 and 1925. This division correspondes to two periods of intense activity on the part of the Presbyterian Church Association in its opposition to church union; while the gap between 1918 and 1922 reflects the lull in its activities following the 1918 General assembly which postponed further discussion on church union for an indefinite time. The correspondence of 1914-1918 is mainly that of the Secretary, Rev. J.W. MacNamara,

and the Vice-President, Rev. Dr. A. Robertson, but also includes correspondence of other officers. The records from 1922-1925 are the correspondence and reference files of the Secretary, the Rev. J.W. MacNamara.

Accession #1982-1003 consists mainly of the minutes, financial records and printed materials of the Presbyterian Church Association, along with some correspondence and reference files and some of the pamphlets issued by the Presbyterian Church Association. Included in these records are a few files generated by some of the local branches of the Presbyterian Church Association and by some local branches of the Women's League of the Presbyterian Church Association, as well as some minutes of the Organization for the Continuance of The Presbyterian Church in Canada. The minutes, financial records, correspondence and reference files and printed materials relating to the Presbyterian Convocations and other events were transferred from the Presbyterian Church in Canada in 1982-83. The pamphlets, however, have been accumulated in the Presbyterian Archives over a period of some years, and during the re-cataloguing process it was decided to include these with accession #1973-1003 for convenience.

The preliminary listing of #1973-1003 undertaken by N.Keith. Clifford in 1973 made no attempt to arrange this material and so during the re-cataloguing process it was possible to construct an arrangement of the correspondence files approximating to the original order. Although the original order had been lost during the storage of these records, it was nevertheless clear that the Secretary, Rev. J.W. MacNamara filed his correspondence alphabetically by the initial letter of the surname of his correspondent, creating separate files for frequent correspondents where necessary. The chronological division of the correspondence files into the periods 1914-1918 and 1922-1925 has been retained and within these broad chronological divisions the alphabetical filing system of MacNamara has been restored. The numbers allocated by N. Keith Clifford in his preliminary list are indicated in square brackets at the end of the file descriptions.

The records in accession #1982-1003 were found to have no coherent order and so have been arranged into groups based on provenance, type of record and subject, as appropriate. The reference files from accession #1973-1003 have been integrated into these groups in this arrangement.

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The records were appraised during the re-cataloguing process and four of the files listed by N.K. Clifford were destroyed as they contained only routine accounts and receipts. Similar accounts and receipts in #1982-1030 were also destroyed.
