Notes on using the Finding Aid

First consult the fonds description (fonds being an archival term used to denote the whole of the records created by a specific individual or family and held within an archives). The fonds description includes a biographical sketch of the individual or family that created the records, a scope and content note which briefly describes the records within the fonds (this generally starts with “Fonds consists of...”), and several notes at the bottom, which provide information on access restrictions and copyright restrictions.

Some finding aids also provide series descriptions and subsequent pages which further describe the records within the fonds.

After reading these descriptions consult the file list and notify an archivist of the individual files you wish to view.

Fonds Description

Edward (Ted) Hewlitt Johnson fonds. – 1928-1981. – 6.31m of textual records. – 54 photographs.

Biographical Sketch:

Edward Hewlitt Johnson was born in Westmount, Quebec, on October 1st, 1909. He graduated from McGill University with the Gold Medal in mathematics and physics in 1931, followed by a Master's degree in Theology from Princeton Theological Seminary, in New Jersey. He married Catherine (Kitty) Cameron in May 1934. After serving as minister in Long Branch, Ontario for about a year, he was appointed to serve as a missionary of the Presbyterian Church in Manchuria, China. He and his wife stayed in China from 1935 to 1941, when they were forced to return to Canada as a result of the war. He served as Secretary for Missionary Education for The Presbyterian Church in Canada from 1941 to 1947, before being invited to the United States to become General Secretary of the Student Volunteer Movement for Foreign Missions. In 1954, he was called back to Canada to become Secretary for Overseas Missions, a position he held until 1973. As the Secretary for Overseas Missions, he worked to shape mission policy and to strengthen leadership of the overseas churches through scholarships, exchanges, consultations and the local training colleges. From 1973 until his retirement in 1978, he was Secretary for Research and Planning of the Board of World Mission. During the late 1960's, he was deeply involved in aiding refugees of the Biafra conflict in Eastern Nigeria, and along with several other Canadians, organised an airlift of food and medical supplies called Canairelief into Biafra. In 1969, he was elected Moderator of the 94th General Assembly, and in 1970, was awarded an honorary Doctor of Laws degree from Trent University in Peterborough, Ontario in recognition of his humanitarian service. E.H. Johnson passed away on December 8th, 1981.

Scope and Content:

Fonds consists of a variety of records that document both the life and work of The Rev. Dr. E.H. Johnson. A majority of the records document his service with the General Board of Missions of The Presbyterian Church in Canada, and especially his involvement in relief efforts during the Nigeria/Biafra conflict of the late 1960s. Other records reflect some of his work on various committees and church councils including the Canadian Council of Churches and the World Council of Churches, as well as aspects of his work as a lecturer at Knox College, Toronto, and the New Brunswick Theological Seminary in New Jersey. The fonds also consists of some of his writings, including sermons, addresses, articles and also draft copies of a book on China. The fonds has been arranged into the following nine series: 1). Personal Papers; 2). Writings; 3). Sermons and Addresses; 4). Student Volunteer Movement Correspondence; 5). College/University Files; 6). Moderator Files; 7). General Board of Missions Files; 8). Committees, Councils and Conferences Files; and 9). Subject Reference Files.
