Introduction

This collection comprises approximately 1 metre of annual reports, periodicals and histories of the Women's Missionary Society (Eastern Division). The records cover the period 1880-1988, during which time the Society changed its name on five occasions.

Some of the records of the W.M.S. (E.D.) prior to 1925 are held by the United Church Archives. Related material can be found in the records of the Foreign Mission Committee and other mission committees and boards. The archives of the W.M.S. (E.D.) and the Atlantic Mission Society are held in First Presbyterian Church, Prince Street, Pictou, Nova Scotia, B0K 1H0. Application to see these archives should be made through the Historical Secretary of the Atlantic Mission Society.

The arrangement and description of these papers was funded by the Arrangement and Description Backlog Reduction Cost-Shared Co-operative Program and by a grant from the Women's Missionary Society (Western Division) of the Presbyterian Church in Canada. The work was undertaken by Elspeth Reid, supervised by Kim Moir in 1988.

Historical Sketch

The Woman's Missionary Society of the Presbyterian Church in Canada (Eastern Division) began as the Halifax Woman's Foreign Missionary Society of the Presbyterian Church in Canada (E.D.) which was organized in 1876. The first auxiliaries were established in 1877 and the first Presbyterials in 1885, at which time the name Halifax was dropped and the Society became the Woman's Foreign Missionary Society, (Eastern Division). In 1905 the work of the Society was extended to include home missions and in 1910 it was re-named the Woman's Foreign and Home Missionary Society. In 1915, following the union of the three western women's missionary societies and their adoption of the name, the Women's Missionary Society (W.D.) the Maritime society changed its name to the Woman's Missionary Society of the Presbyterian Church in Canada (Eastern Section). In 1933 the name was altered to W.M.S.(Eastern Division) and in 1986 the society became the Atlantic Mission Society.

The work of the W.M.S. (E.D.) parallels that of the W.M.S. (W.D.). There was financial support for missionaries and projects in British Guiana, India, Taiwan Korea and with Koreans in Japan, as well as work with immigrants in the Maritime provinces, church extension, summer camps and port work. The W.M.S. (E.D.) was also responsible for missionary education and prepared materials for use in mission study in adult and children's groups, and with the help of the W.M.S. (W.D.) set up adult training courses and leadership conferences.

The first periodical of the W.M.S. (E.D.) was a monthly leaflet which at its second issue was named <u>The Message</u>. In September 1924, at the annual meeting of the W.M.S. (E.S.) those proposing to enter the United Church of Canada were in the majority and in a relatively amicable atmosphere the editor and secretary-treasurer of <u>The Message</u> resigned and were replaced by pro-unionists. The title passed to the United Church in 1925 and subsequently was merged in a new periodical, <u>The Missionary Monthly</u>. The non-concurring Presbyterians who reformed as the W.M.S. (E.S.) set up a periodical which they named <u>The Presbyterian Message</u> and, the previous editor and secretary-treasurer were appointed to this periodical. The numbering of the issues of <u>The Presbyterian Message</u> indicate changes in opinion over whether this was a new periodical or a continuation of <u>The Message</u>: after some confusion the numbering became continuous from the first issue of <u>The Message</u>:

Archival Arrangement

This collection consists of approximately 1 metre of published annual reports of the W.F.M.S. (E.S.) and the W.M.S. (E.D.), and periodicals and a few publications. The annual reports and periodicals are arranged in chronological order, and it should be noted that there are several gaps in both series. From 1968 the annual report was published as an issue of <u>The Presbyterian Message</u>. There are three files which contain other printed materials and these have been listed

after the annual reports. The publications, which were all published by the W.M.S. (E.D.) have been listed in alphabetical order of title and smaller pamphlets have been placed at the end of the publications. The periodicals are located in the periodical section and should be requested by title and year of issue. Missing issues are indicated in brackets with the prefix "ex."
