Knox Presbyterian Church

Historical Sketch

Knox Presbyterian Church (Oakville, ON) was established in 1833. The congregation began to meet in a small wooden building beside the Sixteen Mile Creek. The first minister to conduct a Presbyterian service in the area was the Rev. Edwards Marsh as a part of the American Home Mission group. The influence of the American church faded and was replaced in 1836 by the rise of the Scotch Kirk. The name of the church at that time was The Oakville Presbyterian Church. From 1844 the congregation was a joint session with Knox Sixteen. In 1844 the united congregation joined the Presbyterian Church of Canada (Free Church). The connection between the united charge of Oakville and Knox Sixteen was severed in 1882. A new church building was opened in 1888. It was at this time that the name of the congregation became Knox Presbyterian Church. The congregation voted against Church Union in 1925 and remained with The Presbyterian Church in Canada.

Historical Sketch

St. Paul's Presbyterian Church, Oil Springs was established in 1925 when a minority decided to remain with The Presbyterian Church in Canada. The original congregation was established in 1858, linked with the congregation in Petrolia. In the 1880s, Petrolia became a separate charge and Oil Springs became a mission station. The church property was sold back to the continuing Presbyterians for a nominal sum in 1928. In 1926 St. Paul's was linked with Knox Presbyterian Church, Thedford to form a two-point charge and in 1964 the congregation was dissolved.

Historical Sketch

St. Andrew's Presbyterian Church (Orillia, Ont.) was organized in 1851 with the Rev. John Gray as the first minister. The congregation was known as Orillia Presbyterian Church until 1989 when they took on the name St. Andrew's. The first church building was constructed in 1852 and underwent two expansions before it was eventually torn down, and a new church was built in 1889. The congregation rejected Church Union in 1925.

Historical Sketch

Grace Presbyterian Church (Orleans, Ont.) was officially established by the Presbytery of Ottawa on January 4, 1981. The congregation began in 1980 when Gordon Kouwenberg was appointed as a missionary to Orleans by the Board of World Mission. He began establishing the congregation on August 1, 1980. The first service was held on September 14, 1980, at Convent Glen Elementary School. Later, the congregation met in the Terry Fox Elementary School. The Rev. Gordon Kouwenberg was inducted as the first minister of Grace Presbyterian on May 10, 1987. A new church was built on Tenth Line Road and was opened and dedicated October 27, 1989. The congregation became self-supporting in 1992.

Historical Sketch

The first Presbyterian church in Ormstown was organized in the 1830s. A new church building was constructed in 1869 and given the name St. Paul's. The majority of the congregation voted in favour of Church Union, and a new continuing Presbyterian church was organized as a two-point charge with Rockburn, an arrangement which last until 1955 when it was joined instead with Valleyfield. As the church building had become a United Church, the new congregation had a new building constructed in 1931. In 1964, Ormstown was separated from Valleyfield and operating as a single charge until it was again joined with Rockburn. They became separate charges in 2009 and Ormstown dissolved in May 2011.

Historical Sketch

Knox Presbyterian Church (Oshawa, Ont.) was established in 1925 by a group of non-concurring Presbyterians. The first organizing meeting was held on February 18, 1925. The congregation later met with the Presbytery of Whitby on August 10, 1925, to present their petition to officially organize as a congregation. The congregation was meeting in their own building by 1927, in the basement. The full building was opened in 1934.

[Taken from Knox's website before it was removed]:

KNOX PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH used to be the oldest Presbyterian church in Oshawa, dating back to 1925 when the "dissenters" did not want to join the newly formed United Church of Canada with Methodists, Congregationalists, and some fellow Presbyterians, but wanted to continue as part of their denomination since 1875, The Presbyterian Church in Canada. The new Knox congregation's building wasn't finished till 1934. In the late fifties, the vestry was added to the building that includes an office for the minister; a meeting room/ church admin office; a washroom; and a lounge. Knox was part of The Presbytery of Pickering within the Synod of Central, Northeastern Ontario, and Bermuda. Knox planted two other Presbyterian congregations in Oshawa: St. Paul's and St. Lukes. The church building is located at 147 Simcoe N. Oshawa, ON. From January 2025 Knox will transition to a new amalgamated Presbyterian church, Trinity Presbyterian, formed by Knox Presbyterian, Oshawa; St. Luke's Presbyterian, Oshawa; and St. Paul's Presbyterian, Oshawa. The new worship location is at 333 Rossland Rd West, Oshawa, ON.

A new building was built and dedicated on November 24, 1950. Prior to this opening, the first Sunday School was held on September 17, 1950. The first inducted minister was the Rev. Bruce Miles who began his ministry in May 1953. The congregation became self-supporting in 1956. The congregation improved the church by adding a new building to be used as a sanctuary, it was dedicated on March 13, 1963. The old building was then used as the Sunday School. The congregation amalgamated with Knox and St. Luke's in January 2025 to form Trinity Presbyterian Church, Oshawa.

Historical Sketch

Erskine Presbyterian Church (Ottawa, Ont.) was established in 1874 following the presentation of a petition to the Presbytery of the Canada Presbyterian Church to organize a mission station in the Rochesterville area. The petition was granted by Presbytery on November 18, 1874, and James Miller was appointed catechist. The first church building was completed in 1877. The Rev. Joseph White was the first inducted minister, beginning his ministry on March 12, 1878. Sunday School started in 1876. The congregation outgrew its first building and the cornerstone for a new building was laid on October 5, 1887. This building was destroyed by the Great Fire of 1901 along with many homes and other buildings. The congregation on Bank Street lent their church hall for the use of the Erskine congregation. It was decided that this location would be ideal for a new church building. The congregation bought the hall from Bank St., and the new Church was opened December 14, 1901. This church quickly became too small for the growing congregation, and a final church building was completed February 23, 1906. During the time of Church Union in 1925, the majority of the congregation voted to remain with The Presbyterian Church in Canada.

Erskine Presbyterian Church in Ottawa amalgamated with Westminster Presbyterian Church on December 1, 2007. The amalgamated church continuing under the name Westminster Presbyterian Church.

Historical Sketch

Knox Presbyterian Church (Ottawa, ON) was established in 1844 following the Disruption within the Church of Scotland. The first church building was opened in December of 1845. The first minister to be inducted to the congregation was the Rev. Thomas Wardrope. In 1865 due to a big growth in congregation size, a number of the congregation left to form Bank Street Church (now Dominion-Chalmers United Church). The cornerstone for a new church was laid in 1870; however, the building wasn't completed until early in 1874. A number of the members chose not to move to the new building. They remained at the old location calling themselves St. Paul's Presbyterian Church which became St. Paul's Eastern United following Church Union in 1925. Knox Presbyterian Church rejected Church Union in 1925. The site of the church's home on City Hall Square was expropriated by the city of Ottawa in 1930. A new building was completed in 1933.

Historical Sketch

Parkwood Presbyterian Church (Nepean, Ont.) was officially erected as a congregation in January 1965. The Rev. Ronald H. Baldson had begun organizing the congregation under the direction of the Presbytery of Ottawa in 1964. The first services were held in Parkwood Hills Public School on September 20, 1964. The congregation purchased land and eventually a new church building was completed and dedicated on March 17, 1974. The congregation was put under the city of Nepean since it formed. However, in 2000, the city of Ottawa was amalgamated with the city of Nepean. Since 2000, the congregation has been under the geographic boundaries of Ottawa.

Historical Sketch

St. Andrew's Presbyterian Church (Ottawa, Ont.) was established in 1828 in connection with the Church of Scotland. The first church building was completed in 1828 by the masons who built the Rideau Canal. The first minister to be inducted was the Rev. John Cruikshank who began his ministry in March 1830. The first church was demolished in 1872 and was replaced by a new church designed by W. T. Thomas which was completed in 1874. The majority of St. Andrew's congregation voted to remain a part of The Presbyterian Church in Canada during the time of Church Union in 1925. In 1972, the Sunday School hall was taken down and was replaced with what was called St. Andrew's tower. At this time the sanctuary was refurbished, and a new pipe organ was installed. The new building was dedicated in October of 1987.

Historical Sketch

St. Giles Presbyterian Church (Ottawa, Ont.) was established in 1925 and was made up of non-concurring Presbyterians from several Ottawa churches. The congregation began by opening a Sunday School on January 18, 1925, with 57 pupils. Shortly after, they began to meet for worship in the Seventh Day Adventist church on Fifth Street. The Rev. Archibald G. Cameron was appointed by the Presbytery to guide the new congregation. On June 30, 1925, St. Giles was granted full congregational status. In February of 1928, the Rev. Archibald Cameron was inducted as the first minister. A new church building was constructed and dedicated May 5, 1929. The congregation built a Christian Education Centre in 1955. Cushman Memorial Presbyterian Church (Hull, Quebec) amalgamated with St. Giles in June of 1995.
